

Final Orthopedic Rotation Objectives: Physical Therapist* or Physical Therapist Assistant Student Full-Time Experience Objectives



1. The student will assume the role of a physical therapist or physical therapist assistant managing patients who have “described types of patients students will see” under the supervision of one or more clinical instructor(s).
2. The student will assume the role of a physical therapist by screening, examining, evaluating, diagnosing, establishing a prognosis within a plan of care, conducting interventions, and conducting outcomes assessment and evaluation of patients/clients.*
3. The student will participate in an interdisciplinary team.
4. The student will participate in planning their learning experience according to mutually agreed upon objectives between the program, the student, and the facility.
5. The student will demonstrate comprehensive patient care.
6. The student will demonstrate the ability to establish priorities in patient care.
7. The student will demonstrate the ability to determine appropriate discharge criteria with the assistance of the clinical instructor(s).*
8. The student will demonstrate the ability to legibly document accurate, thorough, and useful progress notes.
9. The student will demonstrate awareness of safety procedures and respond properly in an emergency situation if it arises.
10. The student will seek out and identify sources of feedback. The student will also effectively use and provide feedback for improving personal interaction.
11. The student will identify sources of stress and develop effective coping behaviors in the clinical environment.
12. The student will exhibit appropriate professional conduct, fulfill commitments and be accountable for their actions and outcomes.
13. The student will present an in-service or case study that is mutually agreed upon by the clinical instructor(s).
14. The student will abide by the Policy and Procedures established by Generations Physical Therapy.
